



## JOB OPPORTUNITY Granville Island Water Park Attendant

False Creek Community Centre is seeking outgoing, enthusiastic and responsible team players for the Granville Island Water Park. Positions are scheduled for a period of 11 weeks between **June 26 and September 7, 2025**. Water Park is open seven days per week from **June 26- September 7, 2026**. Full-time and part-time hours are available.

### Duties:

Under the direction of the Recreation Programmer and Water Park Supervisor/Assistant Supervisor:

- Provide supervision on the Granville Island Water Park and ensure safety of all visitors to the Water Park through enforcing rules and safety guidelines
- Perform first-aid for a range of injuries in and around the Water Park and report unusual incidents
- Oversee daily operations and provide leadership through engaged interactions with staff and volunteers and ensure a successful, positive, and safe experience for Water Park staff, volunteers and patrons
- Sets up, cleans up, secures and locks up all Water Park equipment and the False Creek Community Centre washrooms
- Train, onboard, mentor and support the Water Park volunteers, and be a positive role model
- Dealing with unusual incidents in a safe and professional manner, reporting all incidents to the Recreation Programmer and/or Water Park Supervisors.
- Cleans up, secures and locks up all Water Park equipment and the False Creek Community Centre washrooms
- Maintain good communication and build positive relationships with parents, children, co-workers, volunteers and the community through active participation and engagement with Water Park patrons
- Assist with a large community special event

### Qualifications:

- Some experience working with children in a recreational setting
- Completion of Grade 10
- Valid First-Aid and CPR certification
- Strong communication skills combined with a positive and professional attitude
- Able to work independently and as a part of a team
- Attributes to include diligence, enthusiasm and a proven desire to develop leadership skills

### Terms/Conditions of Employment:

- Must clear a Police Record Check before start date
- Must be available to work on **July 1, August 4 and September 1, 2025**
- **Rate of Pay: \$19-\$20 per hour + 4% in lieu of vacation, up to 40 hours per week, for up to 11 weeks, with shifts between 9:30am-6:30pm or 12-4pm**
